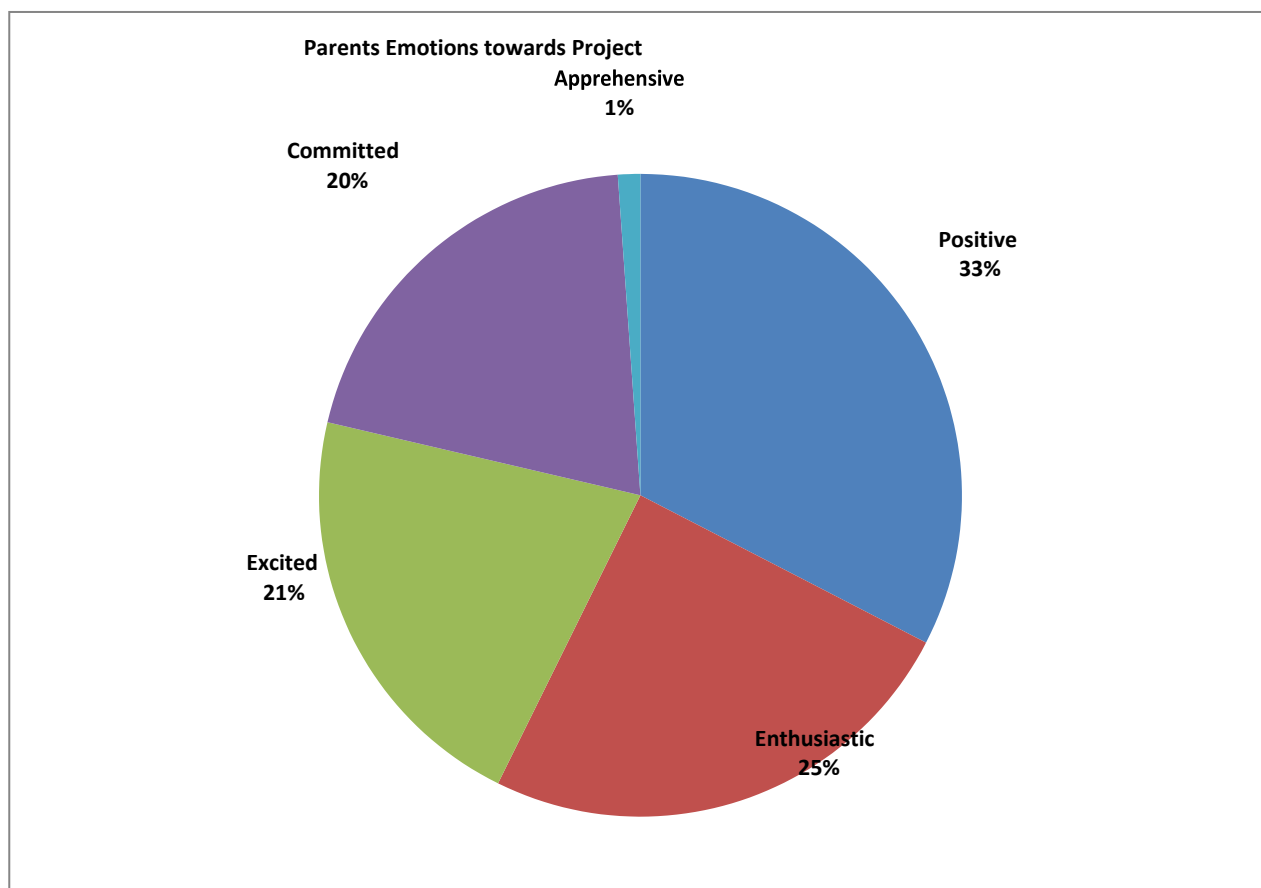


School Grounds Project – Feedback from Parent Presentations

After each presentation we asked parents to complete a short online survey and we are delighted to be able to say that everyone who completed the survey was supportive of the project. Here are some further results from the survey:

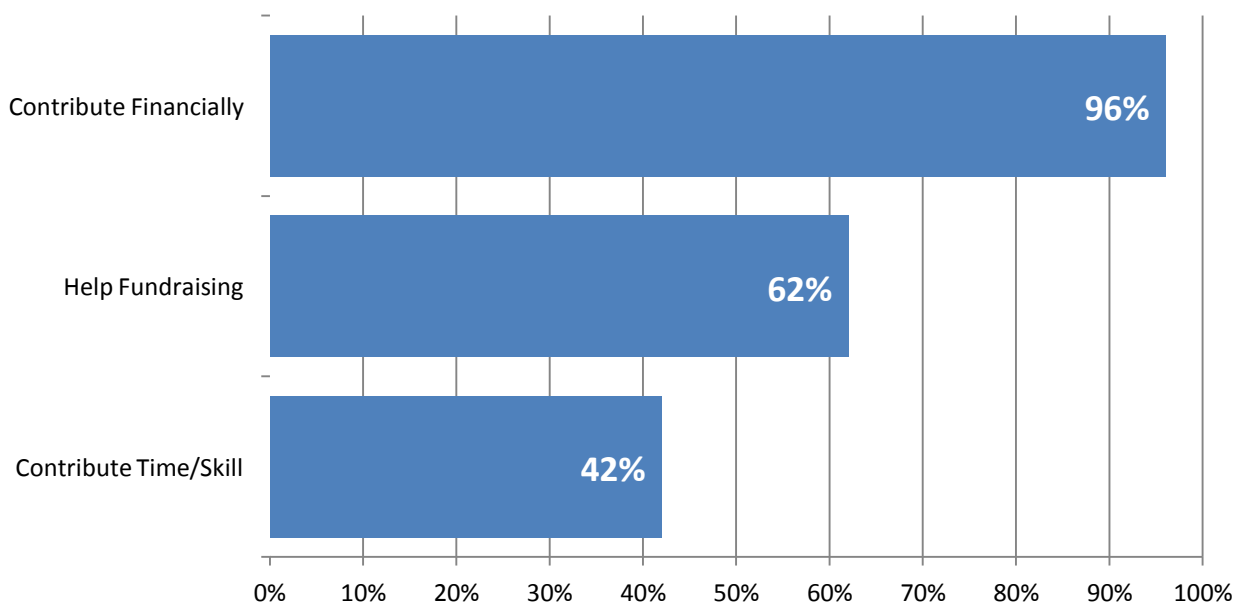
- Total number of parents who attended the 4 sessions – 65
- Total number of survey responses – 50 (network difficulties prevented some from completing the survey)
- Number of parents with children in Infants – 23
- Number of parents with children in Juniors – 11
- Number of parents with children in both schools – 16
- All charts based on total survey responses i.e. all 50 parents



Comments that sum up why parents feel this way:

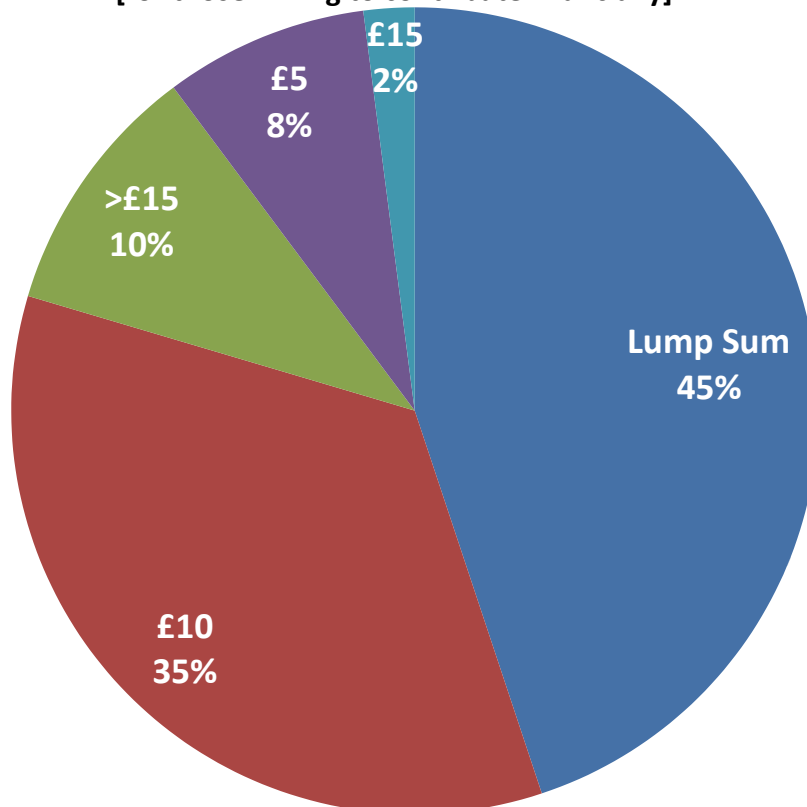
- Good benefits for school, clear plans, less money than expected.
