




The School Grounds Project

Regenerating the school grounds for the future of our children

What will the school grounds project do?

The project will transform the play and outdoor experience for the children. Installing a drainage system across the whole playing field will enable its use all year round. Currently there is limited (if any) usage




from November to May. The Junior playground space will be increased by around a much needed **50%**. This will lead to an increase in the range of sports clubs offered at lunchtimes and enable the space to be used more readily for other outdoor activities.

New trees will be planted as part of the playground

expansion plans with broad steps offering access to the field as well as extensive seating.

What will the project involve?


Based on the feasibility study design and discussions with contractors, we hope that the project will be able to start the day after the Crabtree Fireworks in November 2017.



The drainage channels will be completed within a few weeks followed by a period of ‘bedding in’ where the field will be inaccessible. The playground extension will involve the construction of a significant retaining wall at the edge of the field before re-planting of trees and construction of the seating and other facilities.

Our current expectation is that the project will be completed in around May 2018.
