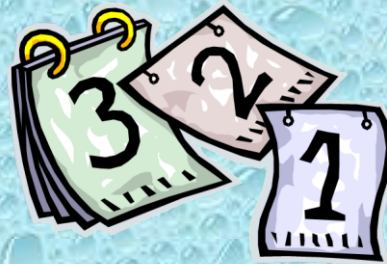

### **Lunchtimes:** Children sign up on the Sports Board. 12.00 – 12.25pm

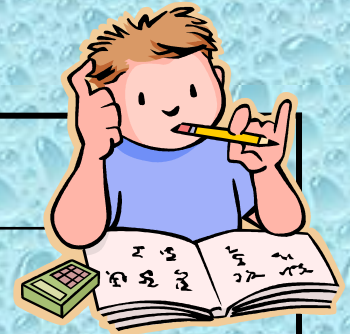
