To further develop the provision of reading in Year 3 and 4 pupils will be set homework, on occasion, related to comprehension skills.

Pupils will bring home a comprehension booklet to work on; they will all be completing the same comprehension, however pupils will be directed towards the questions that develop certain skills that the teacher is working on at any one time — prediction, fact retrieval, inference, summary etc. The children will need to answer the questions in complete sentences and not one word answers.

Homework will be marked with the pupils back at school.
