A diary reminder: We have an E-safety consultant providing a presentation to parents on Wednesday 2nd December from **6:00 – 7:15pm**. This will be a very comprehensive presentation providing us all with a thorough understanding of how we can keep our children safe both at home and at school. Please let the office know if you are able to attend.

Parent Consultations Yrs 4 - 6

This term consultations are taking place on Monday 9th November from 3:30pm – 7:30pm. The consultations are for 5 minutes each and they are intended to provide you with, a brief, understanding of the 'band of attainment' that your child is working within for reading, writing and mathematics and any general feed-back related to 'settling - in'. The consultation is not related to your child's progress to date as this is too early in the term to measure with any particular significance.

Detailed pupil progress meetings will be held in the spring term when the school will have comprehensive pupil data to feed-back to parents with confidence. As last year, the spring consultations will be for 10 minutes each.

To 'sign-up' for a consultation an email link will be sent out after 4:00pm today for you to access and confirm your time. If you have children in other classes you will need to access those classes as well.

Please note the system operates on a first come first served basis.

Finally, may you all have a restful week and we look forward to seeing you back on Monday 2nd November.
