Please be aware that the cost of school meals will be increasing to £2.35 from 1st September 2016.

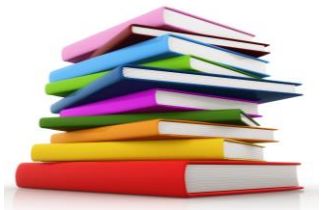
Sports/Team Photographs
