Jousters run fun Breakfast, After School and Holiday Clubs in St Albans, Harpenden, Hoddesdon, and Welwyn Garden City. Providing a much needed service - especially to working parents.

Our club held at Crabtree Junior School in Harpenden caters for all pupils aged 4-11 years.

We are registered with Ofsted number EY396988.

The Jousters staff are all trained with a range of childcare qualifications and/or complimentary child care skills.

A strong emphasis is placed on teamwork within the club with parents, staff and children actively encouraged to contribute to the clubs development.

Our full range of policies & procedures including equal opportunities, health & safety, additional needs, safeguarding children, complaints and healthy eating are all available for parents in the club file.

Under 5 years

Our younger children follow the EYFS as laid down by Ofsted. These children are allocated a key member of staff to ensure they settle in happily and easily, links with all people involved in your child's care are made to ensure we all work in partnership together. For further information on the EYFS please speak with the club supervisor.

Activities are planned to give a broad range of choice to include (but are by no means limited to): Games, Music, Arts & Crafts, Sport, Construction Toys, Outdoor Activities, Cooking and Reading. There is homework support and a quiet area for those who simply want to unwind after a hard day at school.

In addition to this the children are regularly involved in planning other special activities examples include: Easter Egg Hunt, Xmas disco, Face Painting, Karaoke and Treasure Hunts,

Refreshments are provided at both the breakfast and after school club, in line with our Healthy Eating Policy. Breakfast includes toast and cereal. After School Club includes a healthy snack, light tea and refreshments.
