

Crabtree Spend and Raise

Have you shopped on line from John Lewis, Amazon or M&S in the past few weeks or are you planning to do some work on your home?

If the answer is 'YES', did you use Crabtree Spend and Raise?

Using the Crabtree Spend and Raise website is an easy way to raise funds for our Schools. There are lots of big retailers on the website but two that most people will use over the next couple of weeks are Amazon (gives Crabtree 1% commission on purchases) and John Lewis (a massive 4% commission on purchases – and you can even get your parcel delivered free into Waitrose!). You could book your car parking at the airport, or even your holiday – and don't forget the clothes! DIY and appliance suppliers are also on there.

Using Spend and Raise is really easy:

Step 1 - Always remember go into the spend and raise site first (so do not go directly to the retailer's website).

Step 2 - Click on the link below

Step 3 - Save this website as one of your favourites (on a PC) or as bookmark (on a mac) so it is easy to find again. Or maybe save as your home page as an easy reminder.

Step 4 - Find the retailer that you are going to purchase from on the Spend and Raise site (very easy as they are listed alphabetically).

Step 5 - Click on the retailers name and the retailers website will open in another window.

Step 6 - Shop as usual

Step 7 - You pay the same but Crabtree get a commission.
