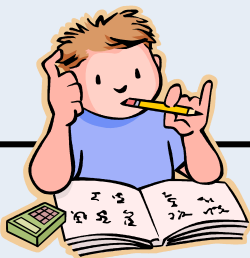

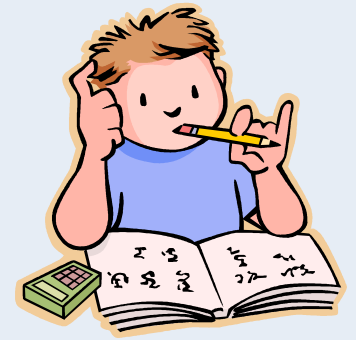

HOMework

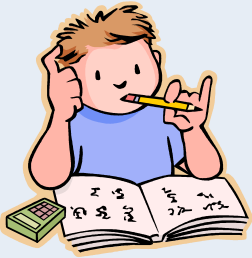
- Given detailed instructions in their books
