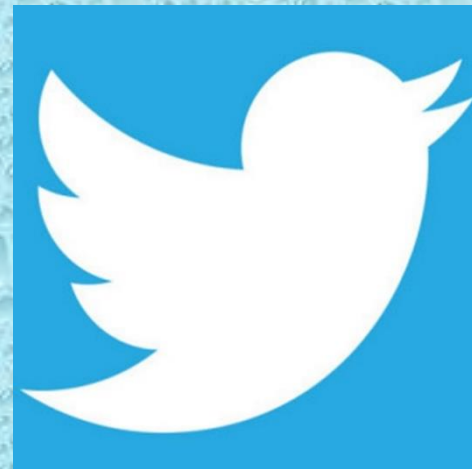

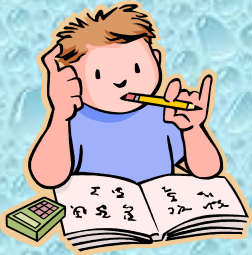

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Spellings

Separate spelling book

- At the front of books there will be an activity sheet- children to rotate through the activities- At least one evident per week to support learning their spellings.

- Reading list on website
- Children are expected to read at least 5 times a week for approximately 10 minutes with parent signing once per week please
- They should be recording:
 - ✓ Book title
 - ✓ Pages Read
 - ✓ Wow words with meaning if they are not sure
